- 5. What obstacles would you cite in honoring, respecting, and submitting to your mate just as the church submits to Christ?
- 6. The last time you were wronged, did you cover the transgression, or speak the truth in love, and seek reconciliation through the gospel?
- 7. Reflect on the words *chaste, respectful, gentle, and quiet in spirit.* To what degree do these terms describe your way with others? (I Peter 3:1-6)
- 8. When you dreamed of marriage as a girl, how did you imagine your husband would interact with you? Respond to you?
- 9. Are there any ways your parents may, consciously or not, create problems and difficulties in your marriage?
