



MARRIAGE APPLICATION QUESTIONS

On Conflict

1. Are you surprised that you don't always get along with your spouse? What things do you need to go to your spouse in order to seek resolution?
2. Are there any unresolved issues in your marriage that you have not forgiven your spouse?
3. Will you talk with your spouse about the hurt behind your anger?
4. What hurt are you unwilling to grant true, biblical forgiveness? Will you seek reconciliation today?

On Relationship

1. What have you drifted from or forgotten about, regarding your marriage, that you need to get back to? Will you ask someone to help you?
2. Do you see your marriage troubles as opportunities to trust God while working through the troubles or as situations that have no hope for change?
3. Are you a Christian? Ask your spouse to share with you their reasons why they believe you are a Christian.
4. What are similarities between your relationship with God and your spouse? E.g. Love, Affection, Impatience, Anger, Blame, etc.

On Oneness

1. What does honoring parents look like after you leave the home? What should it not look like? What areas do you need to change?
2. What does it mean to you to really cleave to one another?

3. When was the last time you thanked God for your spouse? What do you need to do to be more verbal about your affection for your spouse?
4. What are some of your weaknesses your spouse fills in so well?
5. How do you communicate to your spouse that he/she is a gift from God?
Be practical in your thoughts and communication to your spouse.
